CEO’s College Intern Initiative

The Finance Committee met April 17, 2009 and approved management’s request to assist the CEO's Office in its initiative to employ 20 college interns at a pay rate of \$10.00 per hour, 10 weeks, payable bi-weekly. Management is requesting the Board’s approval to charge the 501 (c) 3 Account to cover payroll expenses. It is anticipated that this amount will to exceed \$64,000. At the end of the program, DWD will submit an invoice to the County and will be reimbursed 100% of the program costs. These funds will be deposited back into the 501 (c) 3 Account.

Destiny Academy

At its April 17th meeting, the Finance Committee approved Destiny Academy’s request to purchase 10 computers at a total cost of \$7,450.00. The computers will be purchased through the DeKalb County Schools System and an invoice will be forwarded to DWD for payment against the AT&T Grant.
